Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Magnolia Manor of Inman's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

As of today, 103 residents and 21 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19.

As a reminder, we continue to closely monitor and follow the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials. Only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As we approach summer and states are starting to reopen slowly, we want you to know that the staff at Magnolia Manor Inman continues to work closely with our federal, state and local health officials to prevent further spread of COVID-19.

Since our last update, we have administered more COVID-19 tests and have had additional confirmed cases in our facility. To date, there have been 87 residents and 17 staff members that have tested positive for COVID-19. While we are disappointed to see an increase of positive cases in our facility, we are not discouraged. We are grateful to finally have access to testing that we have needed since the onset of this pandemic.

In addition to the increased safety precautions we have previously reported, our facility also has a dedicated COVID unit for our COVID positive residents. There are dedicated staff members working on the COVID unit that do not provide care in any other part of the facility to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility decrease and we will continue to work with our federal, state and local health officials to protect our residents and staff and stop further spread of this virus.
